BARR ENGINEERING ALUM TREATMENT PROPOSAL COMPLETED

Barr Engineering's detailed proposal for applying aluminum sulfate (alum) to Little St. Germain Lake has been completed and forwarded to the WDNR for consideration. The proposal calls for a series of alum treatments in East and Lower East bays beginning in the fall of 2009, pending issuance of a permit by the State. The proposal also addresses the many questions raised by WDNR Research and Fisheries staff during our earlier discussions.
