Dear Members of the Lake District,

This year has been quite different than last year with a late ice out and generally cooler temperatures and adequate rains. We treated a little more than 30 acres of Eurasian Water Milfoil but did no treatment of Curley Leaf Pondweed (CLP). This was based on recommendations by our consultant Onterra and allowed for a much more accurate measure of the CLP problem in our lake. This should lead to much greater efficacy in future treatments.

In addition, Onterra completed the whole-lake point-intercept and community mapping survey this summer and will be providing the district a comprehensive report sometime this winter. These tools will be extremely beneficial to the future control of invasive species in our lake. Our three year grant for aquatic invasive species (AIS) treatment from the DNR has expired, and we need to determine whether we want to apply for another grant at the annual meeting. I believe another grant will be crucial to our efforts to finance these projects.

The annual meeting will be held at 9 a.m. Sunday, September 1 at the St.Germain Community Center. Please plan on attending. Also, remember the Districts website <u>http://www.littlesaint.org/</u>. There is an abundance of useful information to be found there.

My three-year term as Chairman of the District comes to an end at the annual meeting. Due to other obligations, I will not be able to run for the office again. I can honestly say that the past three years has been a rewarding experience and minimally demanding on my time. Much of that is due to our extremely capable Treasurer (Tom Schwartz) and Secretary (Cheryl Kelsey). It is imperative that someone come forward and continue to lead the District for the next three years. We all have a personal and financial stake in maintaining the health of our lake.
